Key Stage 1 Christmas Performance

With Christmas fast approaching it is time to start organising our plays.

Key Stage 1 will be performing a play called, 'Hey Ewe' and it is all about a very curious sheep who notices some people following a star late at night and wants to know what's going on.

This year we have made a slight change to the KS1 format. As usual Year 1 will be taking the lead with the acting. Year 2 will be supporting them as a choir, but will not be performing on stage. Year 2 parents are still welcome to request tickets should they wish to see their child in the choir. Year 2s will do their own play in the summer term, where they have the opportunities to act, dance and sing. We feel this is a fair way of organising it, so that each year group gets a meaningful chance to perform in a play.

The performances will be on Tuesday 18th December 2018, with one performance at 9.30am and one performance at 2pm. The tickets are £1 each. We do have maximum numbers that we are allowed to accommodate in the hall so we are limiting tickets to **two** per family. We would like all ticket request letters in by **Thursday 29th November** to allow us to issue tickets and if there are any spare tickets we will draw names out of a hat. All tickets will then be given out on Monday 3rd December, to give parents time to organise time off.

Please tick your preferred time slot on the slip overleaf. If you are able to attend either performance please tick the 'either' box, so we can make sure there are similar numbers at both performances.

We are also holding a raffle and tickets will be on sale at the office from 3rd December. Tickets are £1.00 per strip and the winning tickets will be drawn at the last performance on the 18th.
